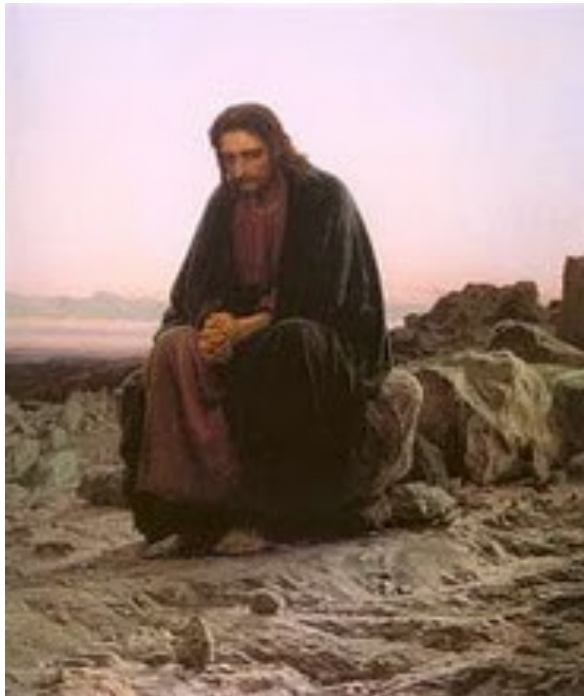

Lust of the Flesh-Summer is winding down, school is drawing near, and cooler weather is in sight. While we take advantage of what is left of this season, doing whatever it is we do in these hot months, consider some wisdom from the Bible when perusing the aisles of your favorite clothing stores and hitting up those back-to-school sales. The eyes of the world are upon you, your sons and your daughters at all times. School children and teenagers are not the only ones tasked with maintaining a holy appearance each and every day and in all venues, but parents as well must learn to step away from the faddish trends that are forged in the wicked minds of people who daily lead our country further into the terrible condition within which it currently resides. We must do this not only for our sake, but for the sake and salvation of others around us.

For all his faults, unbelief, and misteachings, Sigmund Freud, famously non-Christian, still has some viable conclusions of re-

search to share with each of us that can potentially benefit our walks with God.

The teachings of Freud display a constant battle in all humans between two inner forces: *ego* and *id*. *Ego*, the Latin word for "I," is best described as your "self" or your consciousness that Christians would consider your spirit or soul. Use each day for good, and present yourself not as a stumbling-block to your neighbors, but as a trophy of our Lord.
